

**Citizens' Advisory Committee Notes**  
**January 13, 2020**

**Board of Director's report:** Nikki Lockwood, school board member

- Joining Jenny Slagle and Kevin Morrison as new board members
- All three new board members attended a comprehensive training on roles and responsibilities of a board member
- Recently gave staff direction to prepare a draft resolution to waive prohibition for the use and consumption of alcohol at school facilities
- Board will have retreat this weekend
- Board discussing potentially changing the starting time for regular school board meetings (second and fourth Wednesdays of the month) and asking for feedback

**Superintendent's report:** Dr. Shelley Redinger, Superintendent

- Announced that there will be a transition in the community relations director position next month
- Discussed the announcement of a 2-hour delay the night before the delay based upon the weather conditions and anticipated extremely icy conditions
- Announced [planning principals for the two new middle schools](#) – Matthew Henshaw, current principal at Roosevelt, will be at the new northwest middle school, and Stephanie Lundberg, current principal at Holmes, will be at the new northeast middle school
- Search for a new principal at Stevens Elementary for next year begins this month
- Will discuss budget at an upcoming CAC meeting and would like feedback to the impact to schools this year
- School board will also be discussing the possibility of a supplemental levy, the uses for a potential levy, and what timing if one were to be placed before voters

**Safety and security update:** Dr. Linda McDermott, Associate Superintendent, Student Support Services

- School district hired Safe Havens International during the 2018-19 school year to review the district's safety, security, and emergency preparedness practices
- The [report generated 47 recommendations](#) that are being reviewed and connected to resources over the next several years
- Key assessment themes: emergency management plans, training, and drill programs; student welfare and behavioral prevent measures; emergency communications, access control, and other security technology; safety, security, and emergency preparedness practices and other campus safety approaches
- Asked for feedback from members about student experience with drills, role of the campus resource officers to support students and safe school environment, experience and observations regarding traffic safety at and around schools, and questions about recommendations in safety assessment report
- Feedback can be provided at the next CAC meeting
- CAC members requested a future discussion about bus behavior and expectations
